3. Responsibilities of the SG

- The organization of the Training school in Sarajevo showed that it's very complicated to ask all MC members for the approval of the trainees and trainers and heights of the grants (every cost country needs to be asked for approval).
- Therefore, we ask for the authorization of the MC to approve the selection of the trainees and trainers and heights of the grants of all upcoming training schools (like in the case of STSMs).

4. Work- and budget plan (GP2)

- COST is in a transition period from FP7 to H2020 as well as in transition from ESF as the legal entity to the COST Association.
 - *next budget: (only) 170,000 €*
we need to submit a revised work- and budget plan
 - Approval of revised budget plan by SG. MC decision:

president Sjur Baarson informed at the DC FPS meeting in 09/2014 that that the whole system of COST is changed:
 - there are no Domain Committees and consequently no rapporteurs any more.
 - *It is an open question how actions will be evaluated in future*
